Grant #7.1.3 Eucharistic Adoration and Procession Plenary Indulgence: *The faithful who piously participate in solemn Eucharistic procession, either inside or outside of a Church, especially on the Solemnity of the Body and Blood of Christ, may receive a plenary indulgence. Normal Requirements for Plenary Indulgences:* In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace: have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; have sacramentally confessed their sins; receive the Holy Eucharist; & pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff within several days before or after the indulgenced act.
