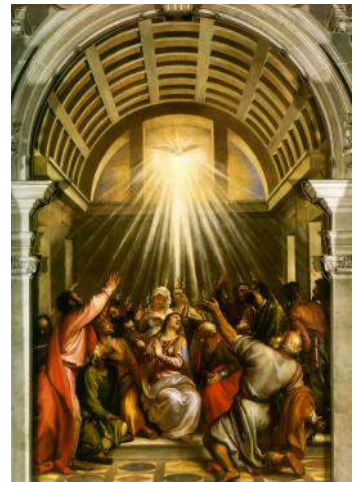

Normal Requirements for Plenary Indulgences:* *In order to obtain it, the faithful must, in addition to being in the state of grace: have the interior disposition of complete detachment from sin, even venial sin; have sacramentally confessed their sins; receive the Holy Eucharist; & pray for the intentions of the Supreme Pontiff within several days before or after the indulgenced act.*
